

## PANYNJ Airport Escort Form

This form must be used when a company is requesting that individuals and/or vehicles be escorted into the AOA, Secured/SIDA, or Sterile Areas of the airport through an airport approved access point or, if seeking access into the Sterile Area, through the TSA Passenger Screening Checkpoint<sup>1</sup>. All fields must be completed, the form must be given to the security agent at the Port Authority - Controlled Access Point AND kept on file in the originating company's office.

I understand that the individuals under my escort are subject to the same screening and resulting penalties and have informed them of such. I understand that failure to follow these requirements may result in a civil penalty, a Breach of Rules (BOR), and/or the revocation of escort privileges and/or my Airport Security ID Card.

## ESCORT PROCEDURES

### *General*

- Airport Employee conducting the Escort **MUST**:
  - Have escort privileges indicated on the ID Card – “EP” or “EV”.
  - Conduct the escort for business purposes only.
  - Remain with the person(s) or vehicle(s) you are escorting at ALL times.
  - Maintain verbal communication without the use of radios or phones.
  - Maintain visual contact with the person under escort.
  - Escort no more than 5 people or 2 vehicles at a time.
  - Ensure the individual under escort engages in activities only for which the escort was requested. Otherwise, you must immediately escort the individual to a public area and contact your supervisor and/or Port Authority PAPD for assistance. If you are unable to do so, you must immediately contact PAPD (on the back of all Airport Security ID Cards) and ask for assistance.
  - Provide two (2) completed copies of this form. One copy should remain with the individual conducting the escort at all times. The 2<sup>nd</sup> copy should be provided at the Port Authority -Controlled Access Point.
- Airline, Terminal Operator, Tenant:
  - Airport Escort Form (PA4274) must be completed for conducting an Escort
  - This Airport Escort Forms must be kept on file by the company performing the escort for one year after the date of escort.

### *Secured Area Only*

- A copy of the PANYNJ Airport Escort Form (PA4274) must be provided at the airport approved access control point when completing the escort.

### *Sterile Area Only*

- All escorts must be conducted through the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Passenger Screening Checkpoint unless otherwise approved by the TSA.
- If an escort is conducted from the Sterile Area to the Secured Area/AOA (ramp), you must not attempt to return to the Sterile Area with the individual under escort. You must exit the Secured Area and return to the TSA Passenger Screening Checkpoint to continue the escort in the Sterile Area.
- Any individual who does not have unescorted access privileges (i.e. ID card) *and needs to bring items into the Sterile Area* that are on the TSA Prohibited Items List **MUST** be under escort.

Failure to comply with these procedures may result in a civil penalty, a Breach of Rules (BOR), and/or the revocation of escort privileges and/or my Airport Security ID Card.

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<sup>1</sup> This form is not required if entering the Sterile Area with a gate pass. This form will be required if entering or remaining in the Sterile Area with tools.
